EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 38 Series of 2024

AN ORDER MANDATING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A STANDARDIZED COLLECTION SCHEDULE FOR RESIDUAL WASTE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALASIAO

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, provides for an ecological solid waste management program and mandates the segregation and proper collection of solid waste at the barangay level;

WHEREAS, proper waste management is essential for public health, environmental protection, and sustainable development;

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a standardized schedule for the collection of residual waste to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of waste management programs, and to promote the segregation of waste at the source as mandated by R.A. 9003;

WHEREAS, consistent and clear guidelines on the collection schedule will enhance compliance among residents and businesses, reduce residual waste, and improve overall waste management practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HON. KEVIN ROY Q. MACANLALAY, Mayor of the Municipality of Calasiao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and existing laws, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Purpose. This Executive Order aims to standardize the collection schedule for residual waste across all barangays in the Municipality of Calasiao in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 9003.

SECTION 2. Definition of Residual Waste. Residual waste refers to the waste materials that remain after waste prevention and recovery of recyclable materials and are not compostable. This includes but is not limited to, sanitary waste, mixed waste, and other non-recyclable and non-compostable items.

SECTION 3. Collection Schedule Guidelines a. Collection Schedules: To minimize disruptions and ensure efficiency, the Municipality of Calasiao shall specify the dates during which residual waste collection will occur. Residents and businesses must place their residual waste at designated collection points (Barangay MRF). Collection Schedule is as follows:

SECTION 4. Segregation at Source. All households, commercial establishments, and institutions are required to segregate their waste into categories as mandated by R.A. 9003, specifically separating residual waste from recyclables, biodegradable, and special waste.

SECTION 5. Implementation and Compliance a. Barangay Units: Each barangay within the Municipality of Calasiao shall be responsible for the strict implementation and monitoring of this standardized collection schedule. They shall also conduct regular information campaigns to ensure community awareness and compliance. b. Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office: Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office shall oversee the overall implementation of this order, providing guidance, resources, and support to barangay units. They shall also be responsible for addressing non compliance and enforcing penalties as necessary.

c. Penalties: Non-compliance with this Executive Order shall be subject to penalties as provided for under R.A. 9003 and relevant municipal ordinances.

SECTION 6. Support and Resources. The Municipal Government of Calasiao shall allocate necessary resources and provide technical assistance to barangay units to facilitate the effective implementation of this Executive Order.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its publication in a newspaper of local circulation or the official municipal bulletin board.
